<b>Module 3:</b> Nov. 10 - 11	Participants, especially those coming from outside the region, will have an opportunity to learn about the local situation and the work being done by our colleagues in the area. Activities include: visiting significant historical and commemorative sites, networking, and visiting local projects.	
<b>Module 4:</b> Nov. 12 - 13	Participants will make decisions about how to advance the projects discussed in the previous modules. Participants will also discuss the future development of InterChange. This module will also incorporate the Annual General Meeting of InterChange.
